- Improve student achievement and build teacher capacity by implementing Dr Lyn Sharratt's 14 Parameters.

Our initiatives include

- Using research informed practice utilising Dr Lyn Sharratt's 14 Parameters.
- Scrutinising data to take precise action that is differentiated to the needs of all students.
- All staff will participate in observations and feedback by utilising Learning Walks, Learning Talks, Collegial Coaching opportunities, Book Club and focused Staff Meetings.
- Monitor student progress through Professional Learning Teams, Curriculum Review Meetings, Data Conversations and Cohort Meetings to ensure a consistent, school-wide approach.
- Establishing precise performance targets for each student utilising our Data Wall and Case Management Meetings.
- Implement Learning Walls presenting Success Criteria, Learning Intentions and Build it up walls to help guide and inform students.
- Implementing a school-wide, 2 hour, non-interrupted Literacy Block for every class, every day.
- Providing unrelenting, differentiated support for leaders, teachers and students.
- Celebrate success and achievements with staff, students and the community.

Provide support and resources for a responsive teaching approach based on analysis and examination of curriculum alignment. Allowing for planning, modelling, timely access to data, observation and feedback processes.	\$10 000
Employment of a facilitator to implement digital literacy and computational thinking skills.	\$20 000
Employment of a whole-school curriculum facilitator (0.2)	\$17 000
Additional Teacher Aide support to assist in the implementation of an uninterrupted 2 hour literacy block	\$18 995
